This is third petition that has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.115, dated 10.10.2023, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC (Sections 419, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala.

After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner since the learned counsel failed to bring to the notice of this Court any material change in circumstances following the dismissal of the previous petitions under Section 438 Cr.P.C., including the first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., wherein a detailed order had been

passed, a prayer was made by learned counsel for the petitioner for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Learned State counsel on instructions has further informed the Court that proceedings under Section 82 of the Cr.P.C. have since been initiated against the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
