1. Present civil revision has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Charkhi Dadri in application under Order 26 Rule 9 read with Section 151 CPC in Civil Suit No.CS/477/2017.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that in pursuance of the impugned order, a demarcation has already been carried out but has submitted that since the demarcation has not been done in accordance with law, thus, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to take up all points/objections against the report of the Local Commissioner at the appropriate stage/during the course of trial.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

4. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the above-said order.
