1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No. 172 dated 09.09.2022 for offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Jagroan, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned State counsel at the very outset submits that present petition is pre-mature at this stage as the investigation of the FIR(supra) is still pending. Further the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender and the order declaring him proclaimed offence has not been challenged till date.
