Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.219 dated 25.10.2024 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh.

2. The petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 20.12.2024 with direction to join investigation with the police subject to deposit of Rs.50,000/- by him with the Illaqa Magistrate concerned.

3. Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that by virtue of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police and



also deposited the requisite amount in the Court concerned and the copy of the concerned receipt is already placed on record.

4. Counsel appearing on behalf of U.T. Chandigarh on instructions from ASI Anil has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police, twice.

5. In light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order of interim bail dated 20.12.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

6. Even, in future, the petitioner is to join further investigation as and when directed to do so by the I.O./SHO concerned.
