MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India by the petitioners for issuance of Writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 10.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Mr. Kulwant Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bhuna, Fatehabad, has been filed by respondent-Assistant Advocate General, Haryana.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record photocopy of an affidavit shown to be sworn by the respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner No.2 and has submitted that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and since the petitioners are not having any apprehension/danger to their life, they do not want to contest the petition anymore. The petitioner No.2 who has been produced by the authorities of



State After Care Home (Girls) Karnal has also stated so.

4. In view of the submission so made, the petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner No.2 wants to live with her parents. Since neither of them is present in the Court today, therefore, direction is given to the respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad, to ensure that petitioner No.2 is safely taken to her parental home today itself. The ASI Kanta Gill bearing No. 175, Police Station Bhuna, Fatehabad has brought petitioner No.2 in the Court today and she is also directed to ensure compliance of this order, simultaneously with SHO, Police Station Bhuna. The police officer shall ensure taking due endorsement of the fact that the custody of petitioner No.2 is handed over today to her parents.

5. Since the main petition has been dismissed as withdrawn, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
