1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for a direction to the respondents to disburse adequate interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that, in fact, they have already released an amount of Rs.43,654/- towards interest in Account No.11004535778 on account of delayed payment of retiral benefits. As such, the present petition does not survive.

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3. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present writ petition. However, he submits that in case the aforesaid interest has not been released on the delayed payment, liberty may be granted to the petitioner to file an application for revival of the writ petition.

4. In view of the above statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.

5. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
