1. Learned counsel for Enforcement Directorate informs that in view of the final orders by the Adjudicating Authority having been passed on 15.07.2025 (CWP-34835-2024) and 21.05.2025 (CWP-1101-2025), the cause raised in both these petitions, has become infructuous.

2. The common cause raised in both the petitions was show cause notices dated 21.05.2024 (*CWP-34835-2024*) and 02.04.2019 (*CWP-1101-2025*) passed under Section 14 of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999.

3. Since the show cause notices have now culminated into the final orders passed by the Adjudicated Authority, which can be challenged by availing statutory remedy, before the Appellate Tribunal, the present petitions are disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
