KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for setting aside the order dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-4), only to the extent of the condition of furnishing a security, passed by the learned Permanent Lok Adalat concerned, to release the award amount to the petitioner, deposited by the respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the award passed, in favour of the petitioner has already attained the finality, and has been implemented thereto. Furthermore, the imposition of the condition of depositing the security is totally illegal.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2/judgment debtor, informs this Court, that he has instructions to make a statement that he has no objection, in case, this Court modifies the impugned order, to the extent of

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waiving off the condition of depositing the security by the petitioner.

4. In view of no objection recorded by the learned counsel for the respondent No.2/judgment debtor, the impugned order 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-4), is hereby modified, to the extent that the condition of depositing the security, by the petitioner, in the like amount, as awarded in the order (supra), is waived off.

5. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
