HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the amount of arrears towards family pension along with interest has been released in favour of the petitioner, however, the method of calculation on interest has been seriously disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner. To this, learned counsel for the respondents submits that a detailed speaking order with respect to the aforesaid context of calculation shall be passed by the concerned authorities within two weeks from today and a copy thereof shall be forwarded to the petitioner within two weeks thereafter.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

- 3. Dismissed as not pressed.
- 4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to assail the order passed by the respondents on the method adopted by them towards calculation of interest on delayed disbursement of family pension benefits to her.
- 5. Rule stands discharged.
- 6. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of.
