This is an application for placing on record written statement on behalf of respondent No.2.

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the prayer of the petitioners in the present petition is that though they had appeared in the

examination in the year 2015 but there was some dispute with regard to the eligibility of the respondent No.3-College to declare the said result and keeping in view the directions given by this Court in CWP No.22711 of 2016 titled "***Amitava and ors. Vs. NCTE and ors.***", vide order dated 16.01.2020, the result of the students was declared and the DMC was issued.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners had appeared for the examination in the year 2015 they are requesting that the date of their result should also be ante-dated to the year 2015 and for the said purpose, the petitioners be allowed to file a fresh representation and the respondents be directed to pass an appropriate speaking order on the said representation in a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation when induced into writing and submitted, will be taken into consideration and the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of ***eight weeks*** from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appropriate representation.
