1. Through the instant petition, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to accept the application form of the petitioner and enter the name of the petitioner in the register of Pharmacists, prepared and maintained under Chapter-IV of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, by respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has applied for registration before the respondent No.4. However, his application for registration was not considered. He further submits that even, the petitioner has made the representation dated 02.03.2022 (Annexure P-9), but the same has not been decided, as on date.

3. Therefore, this Court, at this stage, without going into the entitlement of the petitioner to get enrolled on the register maintained by the respondent No.4, directs the respondents No.3 to 5, to decide the representations/legal notice (Annexures P-8, P-9 and P-12), within a month

from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In view of the above, the instant petition is **disposed of** accordingly.

5. The Registry is directed to convey the copy of this order forthwith to the respondents No.3 to 5, for ensuring its compliance.
