NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for protection of her life and liberty petitioner has moved representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-2), however, no action has been taken thereon till date. He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

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4. Mr. Pardeep Bajaj, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3-State.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
