1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. (presently under Section 528 of B.N.S.S.2023) seeking quashing of FIR No.0158 dated 27.04.2024 under Sections 323/34/506 of IPC (Sections 325/365/511 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Ballabhgarh Sadar, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.05.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 15.01.2025:

“This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.0158 dated 27.04.2024 under Sections 323/34/506 of IPC (Sections 325/365/511 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Ballabhgarh Sadar, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.05.2024 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of re-



spondent No.1-State and Mr. Parvinder Moar, Advocate has filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place. He accepts notice for respondent No.2 and admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Service is complete.

Adjourned to 15.02.2025.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, to get recorded their statements regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 15.02.2025.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466** and **Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (CrI.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No.0158 dated 27.04.2024 under Sections 323/34/506 of IPC (Sections 325/365/511 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station



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Ballabhgarh Sadar, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, qua the petitioners.
