1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner (complainant) seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to get the investigation completed in a fair and unbiased manner in FIR No. 465 dated 03.12.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 427 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that infact the Investigating Officer is siding with the accused party and despite there being fracture in the skull, the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC has not been added. He also submits that in regard to the incident, the FIR was registered on 03.12.2023 and till date investigation is incomplete and no final report, under Section 173 Cr.P.C., has been filed before the trial Court. Had the investigation report been submitted by the Investigating Agency, the petitioners would have filed an appropriate application and therefore, being unable to do so, they are before this Court.

3. On being asked by this Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana, on instructions from ASI Mahender Kumar states that the investigation has been completed by the agency and in coming two weeks, the final report would be submitted before the trial Court.
4. In view of the submissions addressed by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition and thus, seeks withdrawal of the same to enable him to move an appropriate application before the concerned forum to avail his remedy as per law.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed
