1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have filed the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to officials respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

2. Reply by way of an affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh Brar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Abohar, District Fazilka has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka and he shall be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

4. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 20.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of four weeks from today.
