The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to look into the matter by considering the representation dated 18.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) for registration of FIR against private respondent No.4 and his associates and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4 and his associates.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is minor and is owner in possession of land measuring 08 kanals 01 marlas 6 sarsaia situated in the area of village Langah. He further submits that respondent No.4, who is brother of the deceased father of the petitioner, has an eye over the property of the petitioner and is bent upon to snatch the same from him. Further, the accused persons had threatened to take forcible possession of the house owned by the father of the petitioner and other property, as a result of which, litigation was started and ultimately, a compromise was arrived between them on 14.06.2024, according to which, it was agreed that the cases filed by the parties shall be withdrawn and rice crop will be cut as per their respective share on the said land. In spite of the same, respondent No.4 along with his associates were threatening to enter in the land of the petitioner and to cut and remove away the rice crop sown and grown therein by the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner through his mother has already made a representation dated 18.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) but action has been taken

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so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 18.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 18.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps including grant of any protection to the petitioner in view of the apprehension, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
