The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.45 dated 08.10.2024, registered under Sections 13(1) (a), 13(2) of PC Act and Sections 409, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range, Amritsar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.01.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
