1. Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No.271 dated 05.11.2024, registered under Sections 69, 79 and 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Police Station Sahlawas, District Jhajjar.
2. Vide order dated 14.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that petitioner has joined investigation, co-operated and is not required for custodial interrogation.
4. Considering all relevant facts and circumstances, but without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 14.01.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute,

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subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
