1. These cases involve similar issues and therefore, are being disposed of together by this common order.
2. The prayer made in the present petitions is against the rejection of candidature of the petitioners on the premise that the Lenial Descendents Certificates issued by the Departments on 21.05.2012 and 18.10.2011 respectively, based on which they were appointed for employment on the post of Senior Lab Attendent and Ward Attendent, whereas the advertisement was for Lab Attendent.
3. Learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos.2 and 3 states that the

matter can be still reconsidered, in case the petitioners produce the certificates, with regard to the post in question from the Welfare Department.

4. To the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states these certificates were duly accepted wayback in 2012, however, an endeavour shall be made in that regard to obtain the ones required, for which they would submit a representation, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner by the Welfare Department, to which learned State counsel has no objection and undertakes to apprise the said department of this order.

5. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, these petitions are hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case petitioners submit representation/s within a period of 4 weeks to the Welfare Department, Punjab, the same shall be considered and decided, within a period of 3 months, in accordance with law, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith.
