1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.188 dated 29.11.2024 registered under Sections 115(2), 117(2) & 85 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 08.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manish Kumar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.01.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
