1. The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to provide adequate protection to petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 15, who are family members of petitioner No.2 and to decide their representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. On 02.01.2025, the following order was passed :

“Petitioners Saruk and Jannati have filed instant criminal writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to provide adequate protection to petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 15, who are family members of petitioner No.2 and to decide their representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-3).

It is pointed out that both petitioners are in live-in relationship. Petitioner No.1 is unmarried and 21 years old boy whereas petitioner No.2 Jannati was married to Sajid – respondent No.6 having a child who at present is living with father. Both petitioners apprehend threat from respondent Nos.4 to 15 who are family members of respondent No.2.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State and seeks an adjournment to file status report.

Adjourned to 28.01.2025 for filing status report.

In the meantime, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to consider representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps to protect their life if required. Both petitioners and respondent No.6 are directed to appear in person on the next date of hearing.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, status report by way of an affidavit dated 26.01.2025 of Ajaib Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur Jhirka on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.
4. Learned State counsel refers to the status report and submits that the petitioners have solemnized marriage with each other on 11.12.2024 and their statements were recorded by the jurisdictional police authorities, which are annexed with the status report as Annexures R-2 and R-3 respectively. The petitioners have stated that they do not require any police protection and do not apprehend danger from the relatives.
5. In view of the status report filed by respondent Nos.1 to 3-State, no further directions are required to be passed in the present petition and the same stands disposed of.
