1. Prayer in this petition is for directing respondent authorities to immediately grant further extension to petitioner-firm for a period of 5 years in terms of clause 32 of 'Concession Agreement' dated 03.01.2017 (Annexure P-2) in respect of the work namely "Operation and Maintenance of Tourist Reception Centre and Multilevel Parking at Wagha Border, Amritsar on PPP Mode".

2. Learned counsel for respondents submit that this petition, is rendered infructuous as an extension of five years w.e.f. 29.12.2024 has been afforded to petitioner on the same terms and conditions as stipulated in the existing agreement. Due intimation in this regard has been sent to petitioner on 16.07.2025. Copy of communications dated 15.07.2025 and 16.07.2025 furnished in Court today, are taken on record subject to just

exceptions. It is submitted that petitioner vide communication dated 15.07.2025 had undertaken to withdraw present writ petition on formal extension of the project for another term of five years.

3. Though, there is no representation on behalf of petitioner, we do not find any ground to adjourn the matter in view of specific stand of respondents as above, in view of which this writ petition is rendered infructuous.

4. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. Liberty is afforded to petitioner to file appropriate application within two weeks from today in case any incorrect fact has been placed before us.
