1. The present writ petition has been filed whereby directions are sought to respondent No.3-Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot to grant admission to the petitioner under the NRI Category for the MD/MS (Post Graduate) Course for the Academic Session 2025-26 on the basis of Provisional Eligibility Certificate dated 29.10.2025.

2. The limited prayer made in the writ petition is to extend the time within which the petitioner has to submit requisite documents in the form of Passport of his father in view of the fact that he has otherwise secured admission in NRI Category. The petitioner undertakes to produce such documents by 07.12.2025.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Krishan Singh Dadwal, learned counsel has entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.3-University and has filed power of attorney. The same is

taken on record. He has produced a notice dated 10.11.2025 as per which the requirement of submission of relevant documents has been extended till further notice.

4. Although, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner states that the respondent-University may take a different view before 07.12.2025 but we are not persuaded to accept such submission as in the opinion of the Court there is no cause of action available to the petitioner as of now.

5. In that view of the matter, the instant writ petition is disposed of at this stage.
