Seeking directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to grant parole on medical grounds, petitioner has come up before this Court by filing the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

2. State has handed over a letter of the concerned Medical Officer of the Jail, in which it has been mentioned that convict is having stones in his abdomen. However no rest is required for the treatment.
3. Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied if his application (Annexure P-2) is decided in a time bound manner.
4. Given above, the present petition is partly allowed with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the application (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner for parole, on or before 10.12.2025, keeping in view the health condition of the petitioner in accordance with law. Order so passed be also communicated to petitioner without any delay. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
