1. The petitioner had been extended benefit of interim bail vide order dated 06.11.2025 passed in CRM-M No.54151 of 2025 on the ground that he had been advised surgery and had to undergo the same.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he was released on interim bail on 07.11.2025. His surgery was performed on 17.11.2025. He has been advised rest for 30 days with periodic follow-up visits. He is still medically unfit. There is risk of infection. It is, therefore urged that the period of his interim bail be extended for another two months.

3. Learned State Counsel has advanced notice of the petition and has submitted that no ground for allowing the petition is made out.

4. This Court has heard the rival submission made by both the parties.

5. The petitioner has undergone a surgery on 17.11.2025. There is nothing on record to suggest that he is now medically unfit and is not in a position to surrender before the Court. In such circumstances, this Court finds no reason to allow the petition. However, taking into consideration the over-all facts, the petition is disposed of by giving direction to the petitioner to surrender on or before 05.12.2025, if he fails to do so, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to take appropriate action.

6. Nothing discussed above shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
