1. This is a petition filed under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 276 dated 27.08.2025 under Sections 115(2), 118(2), 351(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, (Section 109 added later on and Section 110 of BNS, 2023, has been deleted) registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner had given a brick blow on the head of the complainant. The matter has since been compromised between the parties, therefore, learned

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counsel for the complainant has put in appearance and has stated that the complainant has no objection in case bail is granted to the present petitioner as the parties belong to the same village and have entered into amicable settlement regarding qua the said dispute including the present FIR.

3. I have heard the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

4. The petitioner is in custody since 27.08.2025 and is not involved in any other case. Challan has been presented. In view of the above, the continuous detention of the petitioner would not serve the ends of justice, therefore, this Court deems it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner during the pendency of the trial.

5. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds, surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
