SUMEET GOEL, JUDGE (Oral)

1. The petition in hand has been preferred under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India with the following substantive prayer(s):-

*“It is therefore, prayed that directions may kindly be issue to
respondent No. 2. to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and
his family from the hands of respondent no 3 to 4 who are bent upon
to harass and threaten the son of the petitioner namely Pawan alias
Dhawan son of Sanjiv Kumar in a false case as earlier he was
involved in two cases FIR No 64 dated 21.03.2023 PS Civil line
Batala with the aid of section 29 of NDPS Act and FIR NO 69
DATED 27.05.2025 ps Sadar Batala again with the aid of section 29
of NDPS Act in which he is released on regular bail on 17.10.2025
now again the police intends to implicate him in a false case and
raiding the hosue of the petitioner”*

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing for sometime has
limited his prayer by stating that she would be satisfied, for the *nonce*, if a
direction is issued to respondent No2-Senior Superintendent of Police District
Batala to consider and take a conscious decision on the representation dated
26.11.2025 made by the petitioner (copy whereof has been annexed as
Annexure P-4 with the petition in hand) in a time-bound manner.



3. Learned State counsel has urged that he has no objection in case limited prayer made by the petitioner, for decision of his representation dated 26.11.2025 (Annexure P-4), is directed for.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the rival party(s) and upon perusal of the paper-book, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the petition in hand with the following directions:

- (i) Senior Superintendent of Police District Batala is mandated to look into the representation dated 26.11.2025 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner, objectively consider the grievance(s) raised therein & take ratiocinated decision thereupon within a period of 15 days from today. Said decision be conveyed to the petitioner within 7 days thereafter.
- (ii) No order as to costs.
