AARADHNA SAWHNEY, J. (ORAL)

1. Apprehending threat to her life and liberty from private respondents No.6 & 7, petitioner, a widow aged about 50 years, has filed the present petition, praying therein to issue appropriate directions to official respondents to provide adequate protection to her.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by virtue of the sale deed No.2604 dated 23.10.2002, husband of the petitioner had purchased an agricultural land in Village Khosa Kotla, District Moga (details of which are mentioned in para 4 of the petition). Consequent thereto, possession of the purchased land was handed over to husband of petitioner. It was in 2023 when he intended to transfer the said land to his son that it came to his notice that mutation with respect to the same has not been sanctioned. Only with a view to protect his rights, a civil suit for declaration was filed against private respondents No.6 to 7.



Unfortunately, during pendency of the said civil suit, husband of the petitioner died. Pursuant thereto, as has been alleged private respondents have been issuing continuous threats to her (petitioner). In this context, a representation dated 09.11.2025 (Annexure P-2) was also moved by the petitioner before respondent No.4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, but the same has not been decided till date. He submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if directions are given to respondent No. 4 to consider and dispose of her representation dated 09.11.2025 in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State.
- 5. After considering the respective submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider and dispose of the representation dated 09.11.2025 (Annexure P-2), within a period of one month, in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.
