This is the **Seventh** petition filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.163 dated 25.05.2019, under Section(s) 148, 149, 302 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 201 IPC added later on), and 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari.

2 It has been pointed out by the State counsel that the petitioner has already approached this Court for grant of regular bail which was dismissed vide order dated 29.11.2024 passed in CRM-M-44773-2024. The SLP against the said order of dismissal bearing No.007001 was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 25.07.2025 with liberty to move the concerned

Sessions Court for the relief of bail.

3 Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that as per his instructions, the petitioner has not approached the Sessions Court in terms of the liberty availed by him. He thus does not press the instant petition at this stage so as to file a petition for grant of regular bail in terms of the liberty availed from the Hon’ble Supreme Court as recorded in the order dated 25.07.2025.

Dismissed as not pressed at this stage.
