1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to decide the representations dated 04.12.2025 and 05.12.2025 (Annexure P-15) submitted by the petitioner and to grant permission to the petitioner to appear in the 5th Semester of LL.B. Examination, scheduled to commence w.e.f. 10.12.2025, in continuation of his ongoing law course. Further, seeking directions to be issued to the respondents to correctly interpret condition No.16 of the appointment letter dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-2), since the same only creates a blanket embargo on grant of leave for pursuing 'higher studies' and not completion of an already ongoing course of study.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing the present petition, the petitioner has been allowed to appear in the 5th Semester Examination of LL.B course, vide letter dated 08.12.2025, therefore, the relief clause (i) has become infructuous and she wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with regard to the other claims of the petitioner.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
