**RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)**

1. Present petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents to register FIR against the officials of Delhi Police for illegal entry into the petitioner's private property in Karnal (Haryana) without jurisdiction or intimation to local police, illegal detention and assault of a woman and her minor child, demand of Rs.40 lacs and their forceful abduction and further for transfer of investigation to an independent agency such as CBI/SIT. Further prayer has been made for directing all the respondents to make sure that petitioner is not harassed and troubled by any means during the investigation.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that house of the petitioner has been raided by the respondents in violation of the

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established provisions of law. He submits that for the redressal of her grievance, petitioner has filed representation before various authorities but no action has been taken till date. He submits that she has filed a representation dated 30.09.2025 (Annexure P-10) before the Superintendent of Police, Karnal but the same has also not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if the representation filed by her is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, A.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Karnal is directed to decide the representation dated 30.09.2025 (Annexure P-10) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

6. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
