RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to provide police protection to the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioners and the respondent were earlier partners, however, due to subsequent differences between them, the petitioners apprehend threat and have therefore approached this Court. He further submits that the petitioners seek protection of their life and liberty.

3. Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 7 submits that it is the petitioners who are responsible for the dispute and not the answering respondents.

4. Learned State counsel submits that the contentions raised by learned Senior counsel are factually incorrect. He further submits that the petitioners have already filed their representation/complaint to the SHO, Urban Estate, District Hisar-respondent No.3. The said SHO has repeatedly called them to appear for hearing their grievances; however, on one pretext or another, they have failed to appear till date.

5. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that to show their bonafide, they are ready to appear before the SHO concerned tomorrow i.e. 24.12.2025 along with all the relevant records and CCTV footage, etc.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties at length. It has been agreed by the learned counsel for the parties that parties shall appear before the concerned SHO tomorrow i.e. 24.12.2025 at 11:00 AM along with all the relevant records and CCTV footage etc. And the SHO concerned would proceed in accordance with law.

7. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of. However, the parties would be at liberty to avail their remedies in accordance with law in case any further cause of action survives.
