1. The prayer in the instant criminal writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, is for issuance of directions for expeditious disposal of revision petition bearing CRR No.107 of 2023 pending before learned Sessions Judge, Sangrur, (Annexure P-3) in COMI No.93/2025 and re-registered in Sangrur dated 06.10.2025 (Old Case COMI No.23 of 2022 dated 16.05.2022, arising out of FIR No.132 dated 04.06.2019 under Sections 323, 341, 34 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is facing hardship as she is required to attend the proceedings before the trial Court at Sangrur after travelling from Delhi. It is further contended that during the pendency of revision petition before the



Revisional Court, proceedings before the trial court has not been stayed. In case the revision petition is not decided expeditiously, there are chances of revision becoming infructuous as the trial court is continuing with the case in the absence of interim stay. It is further submitted that the next date of hearing before the revisional Court is 26.02.2026 and prayed that revision petition be decided expeditiously or interim stay be granted.

3. Heard.

4. Given the nature of order this Court proposes to pass, no notice is required to be issued to the respondent.

5. Keeping in the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the prayer of the petitioner is allowed, to the extent that Revisional Court is directed to adjudicate upon the matter preferably on the next date of hearing i.e. 26.02.2026, however, in case if it is not possible on that date, then decide the same within 02 weeks after the date fixed.
