1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed seeking direction to the Ld. Magisterial Court presided over by Sh. Siddhant Sihag, ACMM/ACJM., New Delhi District, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi for disposal of the application filed under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.'), which is pending in the case



bearing No. C.C. No. 1576/2023 titled as **Ram Chander vs. Gurdial Singh & Others** expeditiously and within the time bound period.

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner states that though the complaint was filed on 30.06.2023, the Respondent/State has failed to file its final Action Taken Report and therefore, the complaint has not been decided.
