1. We have interacted with the child and from the interaction, we find that the child has no discomfort in meeting the appellant and is, in fact, very comfortable with the appellant.

2. We have also interacted with the parties. They have gracefully agreed that the custody of the child shall be handed over by the respondent to the appellant on every second Saturday of the month at 09:00 AM at the Nangloi Police Station. The appellant shall hand back the custody of the child to the respondent on the next day, that is, Sunday at 06:00 PM. The appellant further submits that the appellant shall pay an additional amount of Rs.10,000/-, over and above the



monthly maintenance already fixed, to the respondent towards the school dress, tuition fee and other expenses for the new academic session, along with the maintenance for the month of April 2025.

3. Binding the parties to the above statement, the appeal is disposed of.
