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1. This petition alleges wilful disobedience of order dated 18th August 2023 passed by this Court in **W.P.(C) 10962/2023**, where the following directions were passed:

4. In light of the judgment passed by the Co-ordinate Bench in *Prabir Kumar Saha V. Director of Education (Govt. of NCT of Delhi) & Anr.*; W.P.(C) 3243/2017 dated 17th April, 2017, the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner and no objection on behalf of the respondent, the petition is disposed of with directions to the competent authority to decide the representations filed on behalf of the petitioner by passing a detailed and reasoned order, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within a period of eight weeks.
