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1. Counsel for the Applicant states that the Prosecutrix failed to even identify the other co-accused in her deposition before the Trial Court. He submits that in light of her testimony, the case of the Prosecution has no credibility.
2. Considering the above, he submits that the Applicant should be granted liberty to approach the Trial Court for securing bail.
