ORDER
17.02.2025

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1. This is a petition seeking quashing of FIR No.312/2024 dated 24.06.2024, under Sections 498/406/34 of IPC, registered at PS Shalimar Bagh, District North-West, Delhi.
2. The statements of parties have already been recorded by the learned Joint Registrar. Both parties state that they have entered into a settlement out of their own free will, volition and without any threat, force, undue influence or coercion. It is stated by respondent No. 2 that she has no objection if the FIR is quashed.
3. Since the parties have arrived at a settlement and no disputes are pending, I am convinced that quashing of such proceedings on account of compromise would bring about peace and would secure ends of justice. The Court does not see any fruitful purpose if criminal



proceedings are permitted to be prosecuted any further. It is a fit case for quashing.

4. In this view of the matter, FIR No.312/2024 dated 24.06.2024, under Sections 498/406/34 of IPC, registered at PS Shalimar Bagh, District North-West, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.
5. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
