1. This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking the following reliefs:-

“a) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing Respondent No. 1 (Medical Counselling Committee) to lift the arbitrarily imposed one year debarment from the candidature of the Petitioner for NEET examination;
