“In view of the above facts and circumstances, it is most respectfully prayed that the proceedings arising out of FIR No. 79/2012, dated 03.04.2012 PS Mayur Vihar pending before the Ld. Court of MM, Karkardooma Court, Delhi, for the trial u/s 3/4/5/6 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956 and may kindly be quashed in toto qua/vis-v-vis the Petitioner herein, in the interest of justice, equity and fair play and to meet the ends of justice.

Any other or further orders / directions as deemed fit and appropriate in the facts and circumstances of the instant case may also kindly be granted in favor of the petitioners.”

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take the contentions raised herein



before the learned Trial Court at the time of consideration on point of charge.

6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.

7. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.

8. Learned Trial Court is directed to ensure that the arguments on consideration on point of charge shall be concluded within a period of 3 months from today.

9. Copy of the order be sent to the concerned learned Trial Court for necessary information and compliance.
