ORDER
17.03.2025

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1. Pursuant to the previous order dated 29th January 2025, counsel for Delhi Police states that the articles had been given back to the petitioner; petitioner's counsel confirms the same.
2. Needless to state that the petitioner will vend only in compliance of the terms of the *Certificate of Vending* (CoV).

II, who seeks to intervene in the matter, that the vendor is violating the conditions of CoV.

4. It is already recorded in Courts order dated 09th February 2024 in *para 5* that, “*Since the petitioner is vending from a hand cart, we are unable to accept that the petitioner is required to be treated as a stationary street vendor.*”

5. Accordingly, no further orders are required in this petition.

6. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
