1. By the present petition, the petitioners pray for a limited relief, requesting the respondents to adjudicate the statutory petition filed by them within a time-bound manner, keeping in view also the communication dated 16.01.2025 issued on behalf of the Commandant of the 200 BN BSF.
2. Issue notice.
3. Notice is accepted by Mr.Santosh Kumar Pandey, the learned counsel on behalf of the respondents. He prays for time to seek instructions.
4. Keeping in view the nature of the relief claimed in the petition, we are of the opinion that the present petition can be disposed of at this stage itself, by directing the respondents to consider and decide

the statutory petition filed by the petitioners within a period of eight weeks from today.

7. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
