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1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. On being pointed out that as on today, no cause of action has accrued to the petitioner to file the instant writ petition, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has expressed an apprehension that if the petitioner submits its bid, the same may not be found responsive or it may be technically rejected.
3. The submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is only an apprehension and therefore, unless the bid to be submitted by the petitioner is declared to be non-responsive or it is technically rejected, it cannot be said that any cause of action has accrued to the petitioner to institute the



proceedings of this instant writ petition.

4. We thus decline to entertain this writ petition. However, we provide that in case the petitioner submits its bid, the same shall be considered by the respondents on its own merits.

5. The writ petition along with pending application stands disposed of.
