1. By way of the present petition filed under Section 29A (4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('A&C Act'), the petitioner seeks extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal (AT) by a period of 12 months for concluding the Arbitral proceedings and passing the Award.
