1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

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2. Petitioners have sought quashing of FIR No.707/2022 of PS Bindapur for offence under Section 498A/406/34 IPC. The petitioners as well as respondent no.2 are present in court identified by the Investigating Officer. I have spoken with the parties in Hindi and it is submitted by them that they have settled all matrimonial disputes and towards full and final settlement, respondent no.2 (complainant *de facto*) has already received the complete amount of Rs.9,50,000/-. It is further submitted by both sides that marriage



between the petitioner no.1 and respondent no.2 already stands dissolved by way of decree of divorce.

3. In the above circumstances, I am satisfied that it would be in the interest of justice not to push the parties through trial. Therefore, the petition is allowed and consequently, the FIR No.707/2022 of PS Bindapur for offence under Section 498A/406/34 IPC as well as the proceedings arising out of the same are quashed.
