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1. Pursuant to the last order, learned senior counsel for the appellant has furnished the appellant's current address in a sealed cover which has been opened and perused. The said envelope is directed to be sealed again.

Further, in terms of the last orders, Mr.Albert Shtoda, Attache, Consular Division, Embassy of the Russian Federation, is present in Court and submits that the Embassy of the Russian Federation in Delhi has not authorized the appellant to use their address for the purpose of filing the present appeal.
