ORDER

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1. Mr. Abhinav Singh, learned Additional Standing Counsel for GNCTD/respondent No.2 submits that since copy of the writ petition was not made available to them, they are in no position to take any decision.
2. Ms. Tripathi, learned counsel for DDA submits that they already have copy of writ petition and the matter is under active consideration and decision, in terms of the directions contained in order dated 18.11.2024, shall be taken within a period of two weeks from today.
3. Ms. Majumdar, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that copy of writ petition was earlier supplied at the time of advance notice to GNCTD.

5. The contempt petition is disposed of with fresh direction to both the respondents to decide the representation within a period of two weeks from today.

7. It is clarified that no further request for extension of time in this regard shall be entertained from the side of the respondents.
8. The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
