1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.
2. The Application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.A. 9805/2025

1. Application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed for modification of the condition of the Applicant not leaving Delhi/NCR without the prior permission of the Court, imposed while granting bail on 27.03.2025. It is submitted that the Applicant is a permanent resident of Uttarakhand and is running his business of Tehri Automobiles since last 30 years from Uttarakhand, as is also noted in the impugned Order. It is, therefore, submitted that the condition of



not leaving Delhi/NCR without permission of the Court, be modified.

2. Learned counsel for the State submits that this condition may be suitably modified.

3. **Submissions heard and record perused.**

4. Considering the Applicant is a permanent resident of Uttarakhand, the condition is hereby modified to state that “in case he travels out of India, he shall furnish his itinerary with the address of contact to the Court/IO at least 5 days in advance”.

5. Application stands disposed of.
