1. Petitioner seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against respondents for not adhering to the specific directions contained in order dated 05.11.2024 passed by learned Coordinate Bench of this Court in W.P.(C) 15415/2024 whereby respondents were directed to take a decision on the representation made by the petitioner within a period of six weeks.
