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1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (formerly Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973) seeks quashing of FIR No. 145/2018 registered under Sections 420/468/471/120B of Indian Penal Code, 1860¹ read with Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1976 at P.S., Crime Branch.
